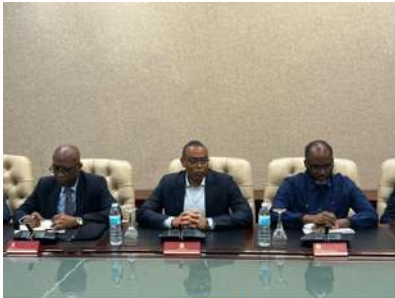

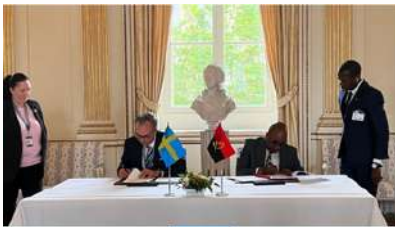

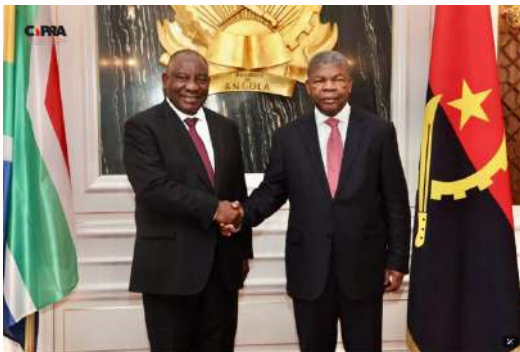

Addendums to contract with Sun Africa/MCA consortium for installation of solar panels in Bailundo, Benguela, Biópio, Cuito, Lucapa, Luena and Saurimo are worth more than 2.2 million euros

In February 2022, the President of the Republic approved expenditure of €399.2 million for the installation of solar panels in the towns of Bailundo, Benguela, Biópio, Cuito, Lucapa, Luena and Saurimo, handing over the contract to a consortium comprising the companies Sun Africa LLC, M. Canto Alves, Vias, SA and M. Costa Alves. The contract will now undergo changes, with several addendums totaling an additional €2.2 million.



Angola is China's largest African economic partner with 258 projects financed

Angola is China's largest economic partner in sub-Saharan Africa, accounting for more than US\$4.5 billion between 2000 and 2022 in loans and financing from the Asian country for 258 projects, mainly in energy and transport.
