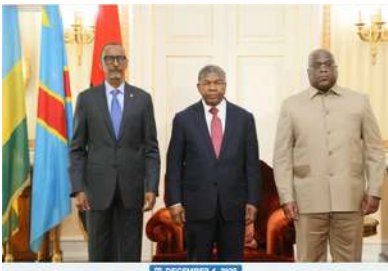

Angola advances in international connectivity with the inauguration of the "2Africa" submarine cable.

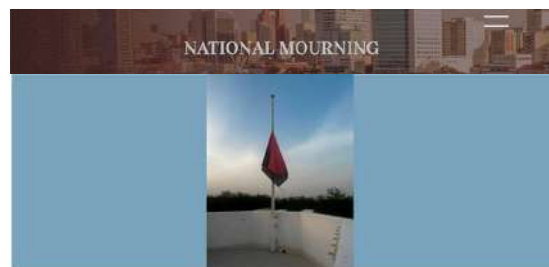
