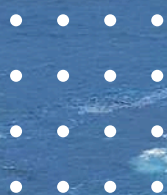

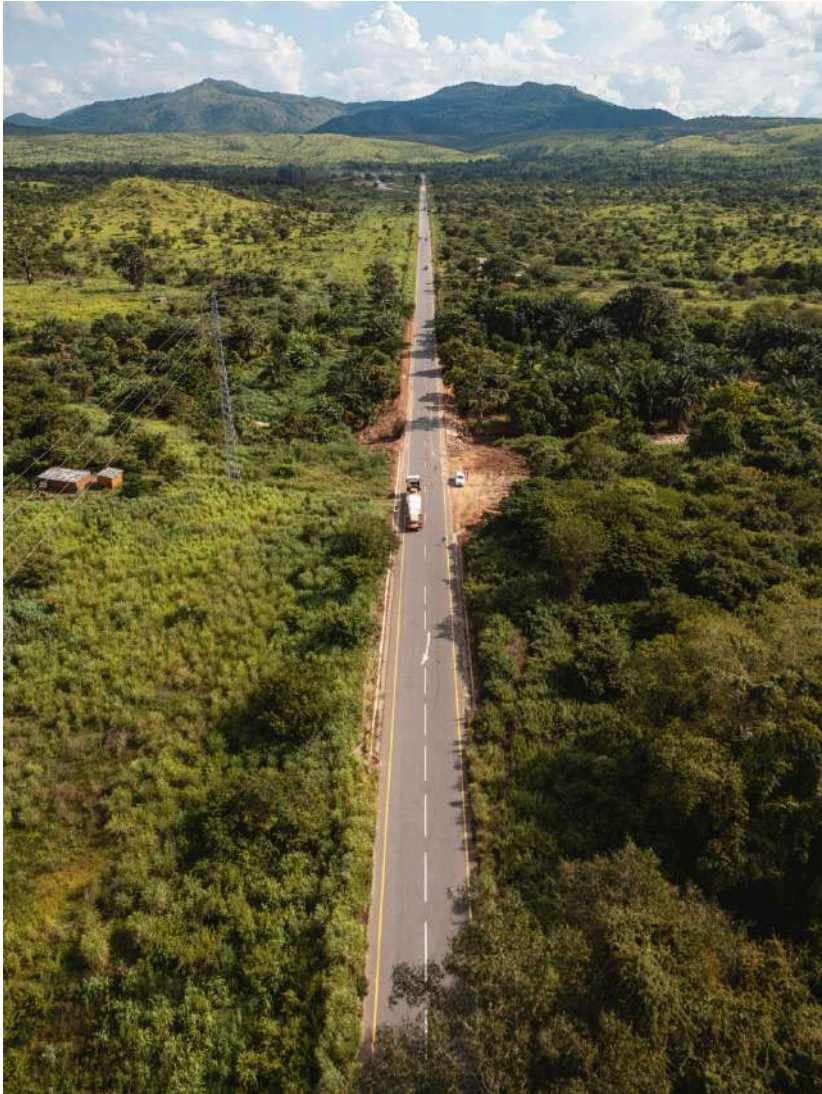

Inflation slows to 15.70 percent in 2025

Year-on-year inflation in Angola stood at 15.70 percent in December 2025, a slowdown of 11.60 percentage points compared to the same month in 2024, when prices rose by 27.50 percent, according to data released by the National Institute of Statistics (INE).

World Bank maintains its growth forecast for Angola at 2.6 percent.

The World Bank maintained its June estimate of 2.6 percent for Angola's economic growth. On Tuesday, the global financial institution revised downwards its economic growth forecast for all Portuguese-speaking African countries (PALOP) this year, with the exception of Angola and Guinea-Bissau, which maintain growth rates of 2.6 percent and 5.2 percent, respectively.

National network of public health emergency operations centers inaugurated.

Construction of a pediatric hospital and hemodialysis center in Lunda Sul provides employment for 700 workers.

The construction of the new hospital complex, which will house the future Lunda Sul Pediatric Hospital and the Saurimo Hemodialysis Center, whose works were officially presented this Friday, is expected to create approximately 700 direct jobs. With funding guaranteed by Sodiam, the future hospital will have more than 120 pediatric beds, while the hemodialysis center will have 12 modern dialysis stations.

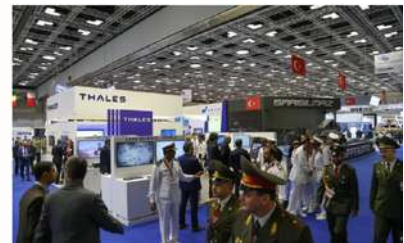

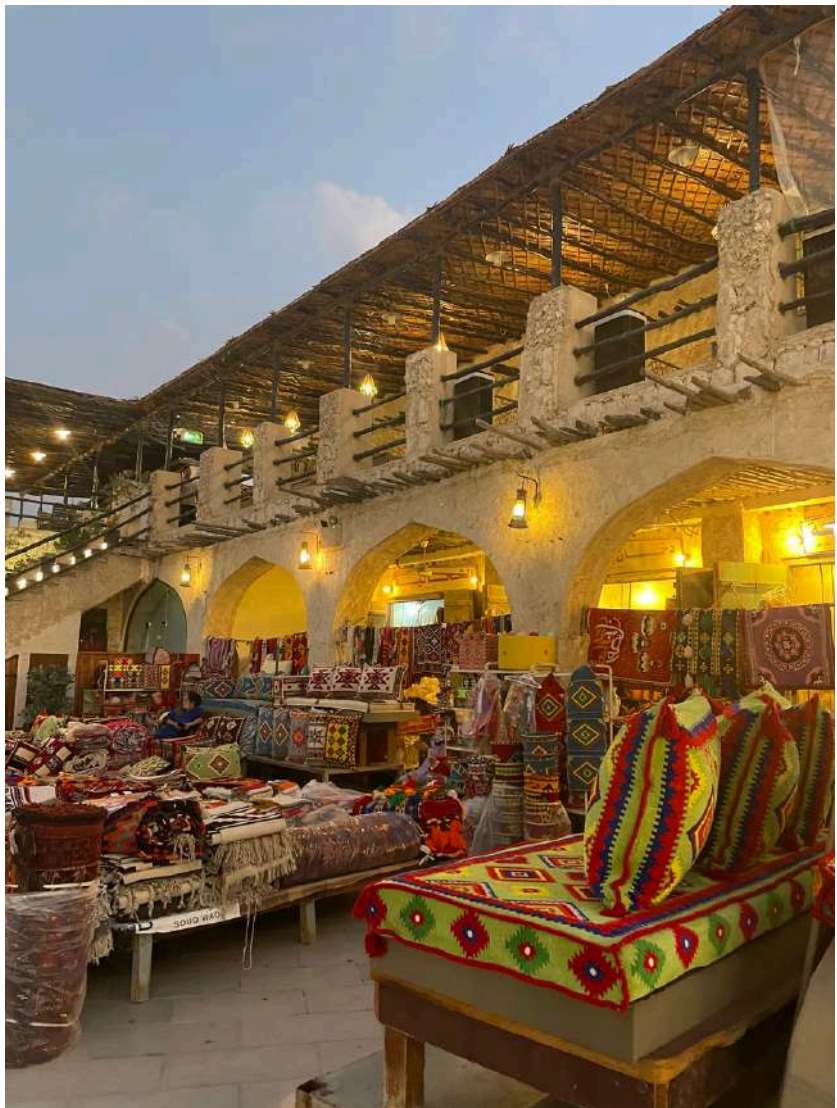
